
HOW TO CHANGE IMAGES

















- 1. Delete red copy over the image.
- 2. Right-click the image and select "Change Picture."
- **3.** Navigate to your picture and click insert.
- **4.** The image will then fit itself to the width of the previous image. To crop it, click on "Format Picture" and select the Crop tool.
- **5.** This tool will give you black bars to adjust the frame of the picture. Pull these out to the size you want the image to be. It should not edit the image itself.
- **6.** Once your frame is the size you want, grab one of the corners of the picture and holding shift adjust the size until it fills the frame. Then click off the image to deselect it.









- 1. Delete the white copy over the image.
- 2. Drag and drop your church logo file (preferably a transparent gif or png) or in the tool bar under Insert > Photo > Photo Browser
- 3. Holding "Shift" grab a corner and resize your logo to an appropriate size to fit along the bottom portion of the brochure cover. (approximately 2.25" wide)
- **4.** Center the logo between the edge of the picture and the white bar approximately 0.25" from the bottom of the picture.
- **5**. Click the edge of the page to deselect.

HOW TO EDIT THE PIE CHART










- 1. Select the pie chart.
- 2. Right-click the pie chart to edit the data.
- Editing the data opens Excel. Use the cells to edit the titles and numbers for each slice. Make sure they add up to 100%
- **4.** Close the Excel document and the pie chart will update in Word. To add the percentages, those have to be manually added just by hitting enter and typing the number.
